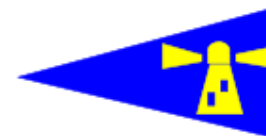
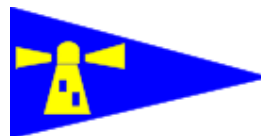
Information

1. **Toward Sailing Club** is on the A815, nine miles south of Dunoon on the west shore of the Firth of Clyde and one mile from Toward Lighthouse. By road, it is about two hours drive from Glasgow, via Loch Lomond. Alternatively, ferries cross to Dunoon from Gourock, a 20 minute trip.
2. Ferry services from Gourock are run by Caledonian MacBrayne and by Western Ferries. Tickets for Western Ferries may be available at special rates. Contact Andy Gilles by 31st May for details.
3. Moorings for Flying Fifteens may be available and, if provided, are at boat owner's risk. Requests must be made on the Regatta Entry Form by the 31st May. Alternatively, moorings are available in Rothesay Bay as well as pontoon moorings in Rothesay Harbour.
4. No accommodation will be available in the Clubhouse, but an area for camping and caravans is available close by.
5. The nearest shops and commercial accommodation are at Innellan.
6. The Local Tourist Information Centre will be happy to suggest or arrange accommodation. The phone number is 01369-703785.
